

VIETNAMESE PROFICIENCY EVALUATION

1. Test structure:

1.1. Listening section (10 points):

- Allotted time: 60 minutes. The content and questions will be read only one time.
- Format: 55 multiple choice questions.

1.2. Reading section (10 points):

- Allotted time: 60 minutes.
- Format: 40 multiple choice questions

1.3. Speaking section (10 points):

- Allotted time: 15 minutes.
- Format: oral interview on variety of topics and situations

1.4. Writing section (10 points):

- Allotted time: 60 minutes
- Format: dictation (multiple choice), letter or email composing, essay writing

2. Score conversion:

- Every skill is evaluated on 10-point grading scale.
- The average point of 4 skills is used to identify the proficiency level.
- Candidate who gets 0 for one skill or the average point under 1.0 will be considered as failing the test.
- Score conversion is as followed:
